

Terms of Reference – Appeals Committee

1 Membership 1.1. The committee will comprise of three members of the Board of Governors. 1.2. The Principal, staff and student members may not be members of the committee. 1.3. Where possible, unless it is reasonably impracticable to avoid, no person may sit on the committee who has been involved in any way in any action relating to the case to be considered leading up to the reference to the committee. 2 2.1 Authority The committee shall have the authority to examine any appeal brought before them and to take appropriate action in line with the College's Staff Disciplinary Policy. 2.2 The committee is authorised by the Board of Governors to obtain guidance, if it considers it appropriate, from the College's human resources department or to obtain legal or other independent professional advice and, if it considers necessary, to secure the advice or attendance of those with relevant experience. 3 Quorum 3.1 The quorum for meetings of the committee shall be three. 4 Frequency of 4.1 The committee will meet as and when required. Meetings 5 Responsibilities 5.1 To consider the grounds for appeal against sanctions applied of the under the College's Staff Disciplinary Policy. Committee 5.2 The committee will follow the procedure as set out in the College's Staff Disciplinary Policy.
