When does this start and end?

What are the entry requirements?

As part of the application process, you will be asked to complete a short English assessment so that we can find your level.

You can also access this course if you already have a Functional Skills English Entry Level 3 qualification; make sure that you mention this on your application.

You may already have an Entry Level 3 qualification in English and are working towards Level 1, or if you have already been working on your reading, writing and speaking and listening

skills and made good progress, then why not apply for this nationally-recognised English qualification?

You can progress on to Functional Skills English Level 2 which is acceptable to some universities, as well as a qualification which employers look for.

This means, if you're aged 19 or over, the government will fund your English and Maths studies until you achieve either of these grades whether you are in work or not.
