What are the entry requirements?

As part of the application process you will be required to complete an English assessment. This will ensure that we have you on the level which is right for you.

You can also access this course if you already have a Functional Skills English Level 1 course; make sure that you mention this on your application.

Please do be aware that there is a requirement to deliver a short presentation as part of this course, but you will be coached and developed as needed to make you feel comfortable about doing

Course description

If you have reached the point where you would like to change direction, perhaps with a new job or to study for a new career, then a Level 2 English qualification is really going to help. This is a must for many employers, and also to allow you to study at Level 3 and above.

This course has been developed specifically to help adults to develop their English skills in real-life situations, including the workplace. The everyday skills which you will learn at this level will provide you with the platform you need to progress and achieve your goals.

What can this course lead to?

Functional Skills Level 2 qualifications are now regularly accepted in universities for Higher Education studies depending upon the degree, but will also be a requirement for many Level 3 study programmes.

This qualification also makes you more competitive in the jobs market as employers value applicants with Level 2 English and maths qualifications.

This means, if you're aged 19 or over, the government will fund your English and Maths studies until you achieve either of these grades whether you are in work or not.
