Award in Cyber Security (Award/Level 1)

Cyber Security is the practice of protecting computer systems from digital attack and it is a growing industry in our modern, digital world. On this course you will learn about the risks posed to computer systems and how those systems can be protected, while also learning about the laws and regulations governing ethical computer use. This course offers a Level 1 Award in Cyber Security.

What are the entry requirements?

No prior knowledge or experience of Cyber Security is required but students will be required to have completed the Next Steps with Computers course, or already have digital skills equivalent to those listed in that course's description. Students will also need to be working at Level 1 or above in Literacy.
