Award in Computer Programming (Award/Level 2)

Computer programming is the process of creating computer programs using code. On this course you will learn about the basic principles of computer programming, how to design, plan, and write a computer program, and how to test and evaluate its functions. Students will build on the knowledge of the Level 1 course.

What are the entry requirements?

Students will need to have completed the Computer Programming (Level 1) course in order to join this course. They will also need to have completed the Next Steps with Computers course, or already have digital skills equivalent to those listed in that course's description. Students will need to be working at Level 1 or above in Literacy.
